State Assessment Results Update – M. Middleton

Ms. Middleton presented an overview of the results from the state mandated assessments given in the spring of 2017. Results from Smarter Balanced ELA and math for Grades 3-8, CMT Science for Grades 5 and 8, CAPT Science for Grade 10, and SAT ELA and math for Grade 11 were reviewed. Scores were shown in relation to the state and, in some cases, the DRG (demographic reference group). AP score results were also highlighted and were shown in comparison to both the state and US averages.

Committee members wanted to know how the magnet school districts performed in comparison to Enfield and the state. Ms. Middleton will bring this information to the October subcommittee meeting. Committee members pointed out that charter and parochial schools are not mandated to participate in state testing.
